#### Medgar and Myrlie: Medgar Evers and the Love Story That Awakened America

This book explores the lives of Medgar Evers and his wife, Myrlie Evers-Williams, two instrumental figures in the Civil Rights Movement. Medgar Evers was a NAACP civil rights activist in Mississippi who worked to end segregation, fought for voting rights, and investigated brutality against African Americans.
