## Good News Recap

Credit Union Profile Excerpt:

### Bridgeway Credit Union

Located in Phenix City, Alabama, Bridgeway Credit Union (Bridgeway), the \$70 million asset sized institution faced numerous challenges including limited resources and technological constraints. However, under the leadership of CEO Kimberly Nichols, Bridgeway has developed innovative, alternative lending solutions that not only meet the diverse needs of their members but also enhance their financial well-being, setting them apart from its larger banking counterparts.

### Highlight 1

"The cafeteria at Fishhawk Creek Elementary School in Hillsborough County gets turned into a student-run credit union created by Suncoast Credit Union, of Tampa, Florida. Brynn Latimer is a fifth grader who works as an ambassador for the branch, helping students save money."

### Highlight 2

"To aid in the tornado recovery efforts, the Nebraska CU League announced that the Credit Union Foundation of Nebraska (CUFN) has made a \$10,000 donation, on behalf of Nebraska credit unions, to the United Way of the Midlands to assist tornado victims in rebuilding their lives. members."

### Highlight 3

"Rogue Credit Union invested \$800,000 in local communities through a Member Impact Fund grant which opened to just handful of states this year, including Oregon. In collaboration with the Federal Home Loan Bank (FHLB) of Des Moines, Rogue will make eight grants to nonprofits who serve Oregon residents and focus on affordable housing in local communities. "
