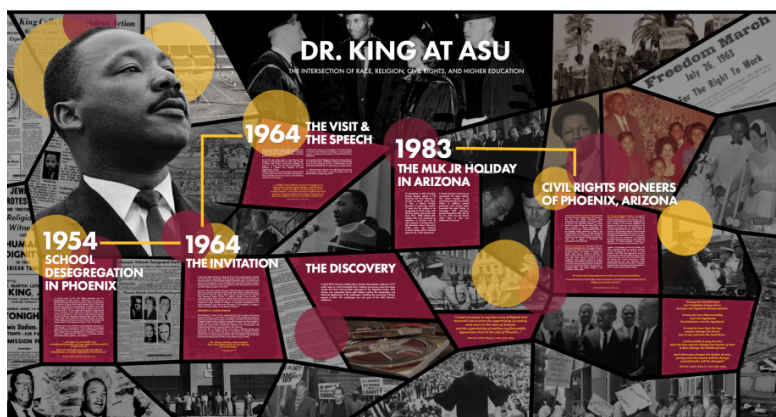

CUEvangelist Article Excerpt:

Dr. King at ASU

60 years ago, on June 3, 1964, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was invited to Arizona just weeks before the passage of the Civil Right Acts of 1964. At the request of local NAACP members, former Arizona State University (ASU) President, the late G. Homer Durham invited Dr. King to speak at ASU. This was a pivotal moment in time for the state of Arizona as it was the only time the civil rights activist spoke in the southwestern state. Sixty years later, ASU commemorated the 60th Anniversary of Dr. King's speech with two same day events that included the unveiling of a commemorative display sponsored and financed by Desert Financial Credit Union.
